Dear Parents and Carers,

Consultation on timings of the academy day from September 2020

Following meetings with governors and senior staff, I am writing to inform you about changes being proposed for next year and invite you to engage in consultation about the following proposals relating to the academy day.

The consultation for parents and carers will run from Monday 1st June to Friday 12th June 2020. The consultation also includes feedback from other stakeholders including staff, students, the local community and our feeder primary schools.

Reasons behind the proposed changes:

Our current curriculum model does allow for a broad curriculum but does not allow for sufficient time for key subjects such as English, Mathematics and other E-Baccalaureate subjects. Many schools have had to either dramatically cut the curriculum time given to non-examinable subjects such as Physical Education or narrow their curriculum offer. This proposal will ensure that we do not have to do either of these things.

The move from 25 lessons of 60 minutes (1500 minutes) a week to 28 lessons of 55 minutes (1540 minutes) will allow students at Pool Hayes Academy to receive a broad and balanced curriculum, with an enhanced focus on enrichment and greater amounts of time allocated to the key skills they will require to ensure they are more employable that others in the future.

The key changes are:

- Tutor time moving from the start of the day to allow students to go straight into learning at 0845 ensuring a positive start for all
- A split lunch in order to decrease the natural congestion created at lunch due to the number of students
- 55 minute lessons instead of the current 60 minute lessons
- A finish time of 1530 on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday and a finish time of 1435 on Monday and Friday

These will allow across a fortnight:

Key Stage 3: additional lessons in English, Mathematics, Humanities, Science and Spanish

Key Stage 4: additional lessons in English, Mathematics, Science, pathway subjects, History and Geography

Key Stage 5: increase in curriculum time, opportunity for further enrichment programmes
