Dear Parents and Carers

As we approach the end of this academic year, we are writing to remind you of the uniform requirements for next academic year, starting on Tuesday 3rd September 2019. We must stress to you the importance of **all students** having the correct uniform when they return after the summer break.

Pool Hayes Academy Uniform from September 2019:

Black blazer (with Pool Hayes Academy badge). Pool Hayes Academy tie (House colour) Black, loose fitted school trousers ('skinny-fit'/slim fit trousers, leggings, jeans, or lycra trousers are not permitted). Black **pleated** skirt (minimum knee length, not tight fitting). White polyester/cotton shirt/blouse (worn with academy tie) with a top button. To be tucked into waistband of trousers/skirt Black socks or tights Smart, black, polishable leather shoes: sensible and lightweight. Headscarves and turbans must be plain black Hair bobbles/hair grips should be of natural hair colour

Our Sixth Form dress code is business wear.

Not acceptable

Black leggings, jeans or tight fitted trousers Black boots or suede footwear Jewellery or piercings False nails False eyelashes Make-up Fashion hair accessories (including headbands)

Caps and 'hoodies' are not allowed on academy premises Outdoor coats are not to be worn inside the academy buildings Hairstyles: no tramlines or borders. Hair should be of a natural colour. No eyebrow shaving

Students must also have a school bag large enough to fit in an A4 folder and equipment needed such as their PE kit, academy planner and exercise books. Small 'over the body' bags/pouches are not permitted.

We politely remind you that students are to wear black leather/leather-looking, polishable shoes only. Shoes must have no sports branding. Socks must be black. The Principal's decision will be final in all matters relating to uniform. We have attached a picture of acceptable footwear. If you are still unsure of what type of shoes to buy, or require support with this, then please do not hesitate to contact us at the academy.

We, at the academy, continue to be proud of our students. We are sure that you agree that by setting high standards in terms of all aspects of academy life we can prepare them fully for their future lives.
