

What to do if....	Actions Needed	Return to the academy when....
....my child has Covid-19 symptoms.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Do not come into the academy.</li> <li>- Contact the academy to inform us via the absence line or text message.</li> <li>- Self-isolate the whole household.</li> <li>- Get a test for the child with symptoms.</li> <li>- Forward the test results as soon as they are available to us via email to <a href="mailto:office@poolhayes.atrust.org.uk">office@poolhayes.atrust.org.uk</a></li> </ul>	....the test comes back negative or a period of 10 days has passed since the symptoms started and the child feels well.
....my child tests positive for Covid-19.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Do not come into the academy.</li> <li>- Contact the academy to inform us via the absence line or text message.</li> <li>- Self-isolate the whole household.</li> <li>- Forward the test results immediately via email to <a href="mailto:office@poolhayes.atrust.org.uk">office@poolhayes.atrust.org.uk</a></li> </ul>	....10 days have passed since the test was taken or since symptoms began, even if they still have a cough or loss of taste/smell. (These symptoms can last for several weeks) AND the child feels well and has a normal temperature.
....my child tests negative.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Contact the academy to inform us via the absence line or text message.</li> <li>- Forward the test results as soon as they are available to us via email to <a href="mailto:office@poolhayes.atrust.org.uk">office@poolhayes.atrust.org.uk</a></li> </ul>	....the test comes back negative.
....my child is ill with symptoms not linked to Covid-19.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Your child should not come in to the academy if they do not feel well enough to attend, or if they have had sickness and/or diarrhoea.</li> <li>- Contact the academy to inform us via the absence line or text message.</li> <li>- Contact the academy with an update on day 3 and supply medical evidence to support the absence on day 5.</li> </ul>	....feeling well enough to attend and/or after 48 hours following the last bout of sickness and diarrhoea.

<p>....someone in my household has Covid-19 symptoms.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Do not come into the academy.</li> <li>- Contact the academy to inform us via the absence line or text message.</li> <li>- Self-isolate the whole household.</li> <li>- Household member to get a test.</li> <li>- Forward the test results as soon as they are available to us via email to <a href="mailto:office@poolhayes.atrust.org.uk">office@poolhayes.atrust.org.uk</a></li> </ul>	<p>....the test comes back negative.</p>
<p>....someone in my household tests positive for Covid-19.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Do not come into the academy.</li> <li>- Contact the academy to inform us via the absence line or text message.</li> <li>- Self-isolate the whole household.</li> <li>- Forward the test results as soon as they are available to us via email to <a href="mailto:office@poolhayes.atrust.org.uk">office@poolhayes.atrust.org.uk</a></li> </ul>	<p>....the child had completed 14 days of isolation.</p>
<p>....NHS test and trace has identified my child as a close contact of somebody with symptoms or confirmed Covid-19.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Do not come into the academy.</li> <li>- Contact the academy to inform us via the absence line or text message.</li> </ul>	<p>....the child has completed 14 days of isolation.</p>
<p>....NHS test and trace has identified a household member (other than my child) as a close contact of somebody with symptoms or confirmed Covid-19.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The household member must self-isolate for 14 days.</li> <li>- Your child can continue to attend the academy.</li> </ul>	<p>....the child can continue to attend the academy.</p>
<p>....a sibling attending another school has been sent home to self-isolate due to there being a positive case in school.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Sibling must isolate for 14 days.</li> <li>- Pool Hayes Academy students can continue to attend.</li> </ul>	<p>....the child can continue to attend the academy.</p>

What to do if....	Actions Needed	Return to the academy when....
<p>....my child has travelled from a country or territory that is NOT on the exempt list of countries.</p>	<p><b>If returning from a destination where quarantine is needed*</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Minimum of 14 days self isolation for all those who travelled.</li> <li>- Contact the academy to inform us where you travelled from and the date you arrived back in the UK.</li> <li>- Self-isolate the whole household.</li> </ul> <p><b>*Foreign, Commonwealth &amp; Development Office (FCDO) - for up to date travel guidance</b></p>	<p>....the quarantine period of 14 days has been completed.</p>
<p>....my child has travelled from a country or territory that IS on the exempt list of countries.</p>	<p><b>If returning from a destination where quarantine is NOT needed:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Check current exempt countries and territories list to confirm the country you have travelled from is on the exempt list.</li> </ul>	<p>....the child can attend the academy.</p>
<p>....I have travelled from a country that requires us to quarantine (but my child didn't travel).</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- As long as you do not have/have not had symptoms in the last 14 days, your child can continue to attend the academy.</li> <li>- The person who travelled MUST NOT leave the house including to do pick-ups and drop-offs.</li> </ul>	<p>....the child can continue to attend the academy.</p>

What to do if....	Actions Needed	Return to the academy when....
<p>....we have received medical advice that my child must remain shielding.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Do not come in to the academy.</li> <li>- Contact the academy to inform us via the absence line or text message.</li> <li>- Forward a copy of the shielding letter to us via email to <a href="mailto:office@poolhayes.atrust.org.uk">office@poolhayes.atrust.org.uk</a></li> <li>- Shield until you are informed that restrictions are lifted and shielding is paused again.</li> </ul>	<p>....restrictions have been lifted and your child can return to the academy again.</p> <p>....you receive medical advice that your child may return to the academy.</p>
<p>....my child's bubble is closed due to a Covid-19 outbreak at the academy.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Do not come into the academy.</li> <li>- Support your child at home with remote education provided by the academy.</li> <li>- Your child will need to self-isolate for 14 days.</li> <li>- Other siblings may continue to attend their school/academy.</li> </ul>	<p>....the academy informs you that the bubble has reopened.</p>
<p>....I am unable to get a test for someone in the household who has symptoms.</p>	<p>If you are unable to get a test in the first 5 days of having symptoms, your child and anyone they live with must stay at home and self-isolate for 14 days. Anyone in your support bubble must also stay at home.</p>	<p>....the child has completed 14 days of isolation.</p>
