## **RE Year 10 and 12 Assessments**

Further to our letter dated 14th May, I am writing to let you know the details of the Year 10 and 12 Assessments which we have planned for the three-week period beginning on 8th June (lasting until Friday 26th June).

Students will sit a range of assessments which represent largely their GCSEs and A Levels (rather than their BTEC qualifications). This is because of the nature of the assessments for GCSEs which are largely assessed at the end of Year 11 or 13 (depending on the year group of the student), rather than BTECs which are assessed continually. BTEC teachers will have been assessing students' work as an ongoing part of the process for the whole academic year and will continue to do so into next academic year as well.

These assessments will be part of their home study and will not be completed during school time following the school opening to Year 10 and 12 on 15<sup>th</sup> June as per government guidance. Instead we will use this school time to support students in revision for these assessments, and to help move their learning forward.
