
INFORMATION FOR UNI APPLICANTS 2020

KEY DATES FROM NOW

- 19th May 2020 The date you need to make a decision on your firm and insurance choice if all your universities responded by the 31st March deadline. If UCAS do not receive your responses, they will decline offers on your behalf.
- 20th May 2020 If you applied by 15th January, universities and colleges need to send their decisions by this date. If they don't, UCAS will make any outstanding choices unsuccessful on their behalf.
- 4th June 2020 The date you need to make a decision on your firm and insurance choice if all your decisions are received by 20th May 2020.
- **18th June 2020** If UCAS receive all decisions from your universities or colleges by 4th June, you need to <u>reply to any offers</u> by this date (unless you are applying through <u>Extra</u>). If UCAS don't receive your replies, they will decline the offers on your behalf
 - 30th June 2020 Applications received after 30 June are entered in to Clearing

UCAS Extra

- If you've used all five choices on your UCAS application, and you're not holding any offers, you could still find a place using UCAS's free service called Extra
- What is UCAS Extra?
- UCAS Extra is a service that **begins on 25th February 2020** and runs until the **5th July 2020**, which essentially allows you to make a sixth-choice university.
- If you applied for five courses on your UCAS application and didn't manage to secure any offers, or turned down all the ones you received, UCAS Extra gives you a <u>second</u> <u>chance to apply for a place</u>.
- With UCAS Extra, you can only apply for one course at a time,
- Please be aware that if you have declined all the offers you received, and add a choice through UCAS Extra, you will not be able to accept any of your original choices late
