Dear Parents and Carers,

Several teams of engineers have been deployed by Severn Trent over the period of time that has elapsed since our first dip in water pressure on Tuesday morning. They worked with our estates team to ensure that the unacceptable loss of water pressure that we experienced first on Tuesday is now resolved. I am pleased to say that they found a solution and our mains water pressure is back up to its usual capacity.
