

Pool Hayes Academy – Summer School 2021 23rd August – 29th August

What we did

Attendance

We invited 200 Y6 (new Year 7 students) to our summer school. Of which we had 60 separate families request a place for their child (30%) over at least one of the days in the week.

We offered our summer school out daily and the daily attendance figures were:

- Monday – 31/56 = 55%
- Tuesday – 39/56 = 70%
- Wednesday – 35/54 = 65%
- Thursday – 41/50 = 82%
- Friday – 32/47 = 68%

Impact

Our summer school has a positive impact in many regards. Firstly, students who attended gave a 100% good or better response to whether they found the experience helped them settle into Pool Hayes in September. Furthermore, the students who attended have all had a positive start to Pool Hayes resulting in no students in Year 7 being fixed term excluded. Attendance in the October half term for Year 7 is 96% despite Covid cases and illness. This is significantly above the national attendance average.
