Dear Parents and Carers of Year 11,

We are over halfway through the exam series now and I hope that your child has felt ready and prepared for their exams so far. In order to continue to support all Year 11 students, we have reviewed our arrangements and provision for next week.

Our original communication stated that Year 11 would remain in school until the end of their Leavers' Assembly on Thursday 23rd June which is due to finish at circa 12pm. However, on the two days prior to this, there are very few students who actually have any exams. Therefore, we have amended this to the following;

- Students are allowed to leave school on Monday 20th June immediately following their GCSE Chemistry Paper 2 at either 10:15 (Combined Science) or 10:45 (Triple Science). The only exception to this will be students who study Food GCSE. They will remain on site until the end of their Food exam at 2:45pm.
- On Tuesday 21st June and Wednesday 22nd June, Year 11 students who have revision sessions can choose to come into school for them. For clarity they are;
 - a. GCSE Music Revision Session on Tuesday 21st June 12:45pm (Music students only)
 - b. GCSE Science Revision Session on Wednesday 22nd June 12:45pm (All students welcome)
- On Wednesday 22nd June at 9:00am there is a GCSE Music exam which all Music students must attend.

For Tuesday 21st June and Wednesday 22nd June, if students are not in for their Music revision or exam, or their Science revision, they are to remain at home and continue their revision independently. If your child is coming in for any of the activities listed above during these days, they are to sign in at our Attendance Office for the duration of the exam or revision session. They should arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of their exam or revision session. They will then sign out and leave site at the end of the revision session or exam.

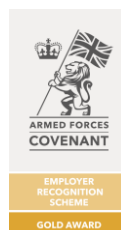
Your child's independent revision for Tuesday 21st June and Wednesday 22nd June should make use of the following resources to which they have access;



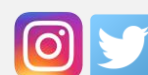

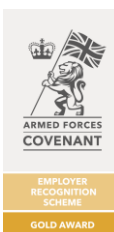
