We have had a really strong start to our academic year and have had a wonderful summer sharing in our students' #PHAntastic Key Stage 4 and 5 results. Also, I would like to thank you all so much for supporting us with students' uniform this September. We have seen a dramatic reduction in the number of students who have incorrect uniform and I fully appreciate your support on this. It makes our work so much easier know that parents and carers are fully supportive of Pool Hayes. We have also added to our pastoral staffing this year. 
## Rewards














## Winter and Weather


