Trips and Visiting Artists

Our Art department and some of our students joined up with our Eco club to visit the Botanical Gardens. The Eco club students had lots of fun exploring and finding inspiration for our academy garden, whilst our GCSE and A level Art students worked on coursework, collecting drawings and photographs.

Today, we have welcomed professional practitioners from ACE Dance Company to work with our dance students in Years 9, 10, 11 and 13. The workshop was to support our students in developing creative ideas for their upcoming assessments.
