

Dear parents and carers

As the Year 11 mock exam series begins next week, I wanted to take this opportunity to inform you about the upcoming three weeks.

Our students will be required to continue attending school every day and it is crucial that they are punctual. When your child has an exam, they will be in the appropriate rooms completing those. If they do not have an exam either in the morning or afternoon, they will be expected to follow their normal timetable and attend lessons, unless told to attend 'Power Hour' sessions which we have calendared prior to all afternoon exams, where staff will lead a supportive revision session prior to the exam in that subject. This information will be shared with students on a daily basis. Students will be expected to wear full school uniform every day during the mock exam series.

All morning examinations will aim to begin at 9:00am, therefore punctuality is key over the next three weeks. All afternoon examinations will aim to begin at 1:00pm. There will be 'Knowledge Blast' sessions every morning beginning at 8:30am so we expect students to arrive on time to be sat ready to begin a quick 20-minute key information session by 8:30am.


Lunchtimes during the three-week mock period will move to 12:10pm for Year 11 only. Lunch will be served in the main hall only and students will be moved into exam rooms at 12:45pm in preparation for a 1:00pm prompt start.

Online NTP sessions will continue to run through the exam weeks. It is vital that your child attends these online sessions as they are being planned by staff to support their revision for the exams.
