We are absolutely delighted with the focus, commitment and maturity Year 11 have demonstrated as we approach their final GCSE examinations. We continue to be impressed by their resilience, the mutual support they show one another, and their spirit.

Please see below some important information for the coming weeks.

Revision During Exam Season:

We have high expectations of student attendance and will continue to do so during the summer exam season. Students will be expected to attend all timetabled sessions as normal when not in a scheduled examination. Our Revision Plan includes, where possible, timetabled, subject specific and teacher led revision sessions every day during the exam season. On the morning immediately preceding an exam, there will be a knowledge blast at 08:20am in the main hall. Morning examinations will begin at 9:00am prompt. Afternoon examinations will begin at 13:40pm prompt. NTP sessions outside of normal academy hours will be offered throughout the exam season. Attendance online to these are vital as we will be delivering important exam techniques.

Please be aware that some exams will not finish at the usual end of school times. Therefore, it is vital that you plan for your child to be available to stay onsite until the exam has finished. If your child usually picks up siblings from other schools, please make alternative arrangements during the exam season which runs Tuesday 7th May until Wednesday 19th June 2024.

Please note: The exam contingency date runs until Wednesday 26th June 2024, meaning that your child should be available to attend school to sit an exam up until this date.

GCSE examination results will be ready to collect Thursday 22nd August 2024 between 09.00am and 10.30am in the Sixth Form Centre. Students can enrol into our Sixth Form as soon as they have collected their results.
