A quiet week for fixtures with only two football games played. Year 8 lost 2-1 to Wednesfield in the league with a much improved performance.

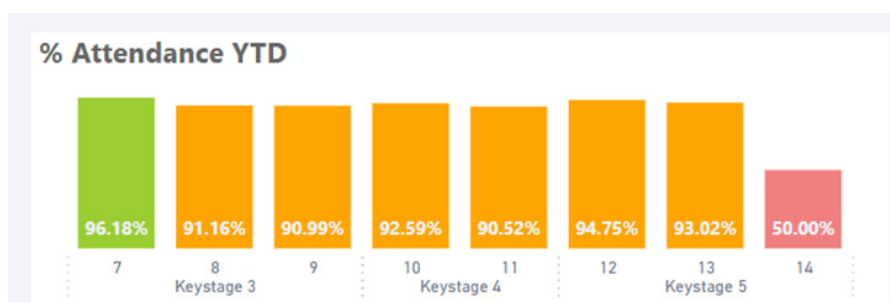
