
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Head of Year Shout Outs

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What's Changed Since September?

- 1. We've worked with parents and carers to develop our reports process, trying to bring to you the information you've told us you need.
- 2. We've moved from a half termly newsletter to a weekly one relaunching the key to develop communication with parents and carers.
- 3. To further develop communication, we have introduced the: My Child at School App.
- 4. We've run 'Unlocking Potential' evenings for all of KS3 and KS4.
- 5. We've introduced Parents'/Carers' Evening surveys to enable us to take on board parent voice.
- 6. Year 11 have received their revision packs and for the first time, we've also given them to Year 10.
- 7. We've tried to make Reception and the main foyer entrance more welcoming. This will continue this year with the painting of the entrance way.
- 8. We've been running intervention sessions online and in person and we are launching our 'Ten Minutes On' very soon.
- 9. We've introduced a student leadership team to help us to listen to student voice and build stronger relationships.
- 10. We've opened our refurbished Boys' Toilets just for Year 7 and Year 8.
- 11. We've extended our extra-curricular offer with clubs like 'Photography Club'.
- 12. We've run our first lunchtime discos to enable us all to have a little more fun.
- 13. We've worked extra hard on rewarding students. Last year our total positives for the whole year were 977,056 points it's now already 789,087 points!
- 14. We've introduced a late strategy to work on the life skill of punctuality.
- 15. We've performed plays, held talent shows, won sporting events and so much more.
- 16. After our own PHAntastival we also took part in the Willenhall Park Christmas Festival.
- 17. Sixth Form Students ran our first charity Bingo/Trivia night.
- 18. We've introduced a 'Know Me to Teach Me' programme to support our pupils with additional needs.
- 19. We've joined the MPTA programme to upskill our teaching assistants.
- 20. We've put intensive support into Year 11's PSAs.
- 21. In our reading programme we've read 459 books so far.
- 22. In SPARX Maths we've answered 488,574 questions.
- 23. We've introduced Pizza Parties to reward pupils and reward assemblies for all year groups.
