
SIXTH FORM UPDATES


YEAR 10 MOCK EXAMS

Well done to all Year 10 pupils on the completion of their second Geography field trip to Birmingham. Both groups were a pleasure on both days - Mr Francis




ACADEMY DRESS CODE


Following a recent survey and after taking on board the voice of pupils and parents, the academy has made some changes to its uniform and dress code from September 2025.

All students are expected to maintain a high standard of personal appearance.

The following items make up our academy dress code:

- Black blazer with our school badge
- Pool Hayes Academy tie - **NEW TIE SEPTEMBER 2025**
- Black pleated skirt (minimum knee length, not tight fitting)
- Black full length tailored trousers (trousers should not be tight, flared, denim, combat, legging or cropped style)
- White polyester/cotton shirt/blouse (worn with academy tie) with top button done up. Tucked into waistband of trousers/skirt
- A plain black "V" necked jumper with no motif or visible branding (optional)
- Head scarves/turbans (plain black)
- Plain black socks or tights
- Smart, black, polishable leather looking shoes without any embellishment or decoration.
- A school bag, large enough to fit in books and equipment your child needs for their academy day. (Able to carry A4 documentation and a pencil case)





ACADEMY DRESS CODE

Optional:




- 1 analogue plain watch
- 1 pair of plain small stud earrings - 1 in each earlobe only - **NEW FROM SEPTEMBER 2025**
- Nails should be short, practical and natural in appearance - **NEW FROM SEPTEMBER 2025**
- Make up - must be discreet and natural looking - **NEW FROM SEPTEMBER 2025**
- Hair accessories must be plain black

Not acceptable:

- Black leggings, jeans, tight fitted, cropped or flared trousers
- Black boots or suede footwear
- Smart watches
- Pouch style bags
- Badges (with the exception of academy badges)
- Facial, cartilage or body piercings
- Caps or hoodies anywhere on our academy premises
- Tramlines or patterns in hair
- False eyelashes

Also:

- Only a plain white t-shirt or vest should be worn underneath a blouse or shirt
- Winter hats should not be worn inside the academy building
- Hair should be of a natural colour





ACADEMY DRESS CODE

This is not an exhaustive list of what is unacceptable at Pool Hayes Academy.

Decisions about uniform will be at the Head of Academy's discretion.

For PE all students require:

- Black/Yellow Pool Hayes logo shirt - **NEW FOR SEPTEMBER 2025**
- Black Pool Hayes logo shorts
- White ankle socks
- Suitable athletic trainers
- Black plain football socks
- Football boots
- Shin pads
- Black base layer for outdoor activities during winter months (optional)

Other acceptable PE kit:

- Plain black polo shirt (instead of black/yellow Pool Hayes logo t-shirt)
- Plain black shorts (instead of black Pool Hayes logo shorts)
- Sports leggings for girls
- 1/4 zip top - **NEW FOR SEPTEMBER 2025**
