Parents/carers will be contacted to collect the phone after school that day, or the student will be able to collect it on Friday at 2:35pm.

Why this approach? Research shows that mobile phones can be a major distraction in schools, impacting focus, learning, and wellbeing. By removing this distraction, we can ensure students remain fully engaged in their lessons and social interactions.
